4. Attach two (2) letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a teacher or counselor. **Family members may not write recommendations.**
5. Include a copy of SAT and/or ACT scores.
6. Include 5 copies of your transcript through the first semester of your senior year.
7. Give the Counselor's Report to you counselor. Have him/her complete it and attach an OFFICIAL copy of your transcript **through the first semester of your senior year**. Transcripts must be signed by the counselor and placed in a sealed and signed envelope and returned to the applicant.
8. Mail (1) completed application (**5 copies**), (2) 2 letters of recommendation (**5 copies**), (3) SAT/ACT test scores (**5 copies**), (4) a copy of your transcript through the 1st semester of your senior year (**5 copies**), and (5) have your school counselor submit a copy of the "Counselor's Report" (it is your responsibility to make sure this is done).
