- 4. Include two (2) letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a school teacher or counselor. **Family members may not write recommendations.** If the author of the recommendation prefers, he or she may email the recommendation directly to the Scholarship Chairman. Any recommendation emailed or mailed separately should include the applicant's name and high school at the top of the page.
- 5. Provide a copy of your SAT and/or ACT scores. If the applicant did not take any standardized tests, please include a statement of that fact.
- 6. Include a copy of your transcript through the first semester of your senior year.
- 7. Provide your counselor with a copy of the Counselor's Report form. Ask him or her to complete the form and email or mail it to the scholarship Chairman. Alternatively, the counselor may place both the form and your official transcript in a sealed and signed envelope and return it to you to mail to the scholarship Chairman.
