INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING**

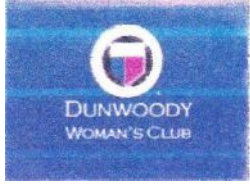
1. Complete the cover page of the application, which asks for your general information. **Note that applicants must live or attend school in one of the following ZIP Codes: 30328, 30338, 30346. 30350, 30360.**
2. Complete the form reflecting your activity record. You may use multiple forms, if necessary.
3. Answer the three informational questions, which are found on a separate sheet. Please label your corresponding answers the same as the questions – i.e., “A,” “B,” and “C.”
4. Include two (2) letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a school teacher or counselor. **Family members may not write recommendations.**
5. Provide a copy of your SAT and/or ACT scores. If the applicant did not take any standardized tests, please include a statement of that fact.
6. Include 5 copies of your transcript through the first semester of your senior year.
7. Provide your counselor with a copy of the Counselor's Report form. Ask him or her to complete the form and place the form in a sealed and signed envelope and return it to you to mail to the scholarship Chairman.
8. **Mail:** (A) completed application (**5 copies**); (B) 2 letters of recommendation (**5 copies**); (C) SAT/ACT test scores (**5 copies**) ; (D) your transcript through the 1st semester of your senior year (**5 copies**); and (E) have your counselor give you a copy of the completed Counselor's Report in a sealed envelope.
